- \* The ideal candidate will possess a Diploma in Biomedical Engineering Technology
- \* Must be registered as a Biomedical Engineering Technologist within OACETT (Ontario Association of Certified Engineering Technicians and Technologists) and obtain CBET (Certified Biomedical Engineering Technologist) within 2 years of employment.
- \* Membership with the Ontario Association of Certified Engineering Technicians and Technologists is also required
- \* A minimum of 3 years experience servicing device Class 1 through 4 based medical equipment and systems or a combination of education and experience in a hospital environment are required
- \* Familiarity of medical equipment, standards and medical procedures is required
- \* Ability to make decisions based on provincial and federal legislation as well as accreditation standards is required
- \* Demonstrated ability for planning and organizing
- \* Ability to work co-operatively with others, possess superior communication skills both verbally and written, work with minimum supervision, and demonstrate flexibility in order to meet deadlines
- \* Ability to work off site at our regional hospitals, within patient homes and fly-in, remote communities throughout Northern Ontario."
- \* Ability to work an evening shift, standby and over time when required."
