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Submission Process

The 2026 CAJC is now accepting submissions.

Please note the following:

- **All papers will be peer-reviewed.** One author from each paper must be willing to review at least two other papers (or designate another in their place). The author selected to be the reviewer should not be a student.
- Authors may submit an abstract (1 page) or full-length paper (2-4 pages). Submissions will be accepted for a **podium or poster** slot based on our peer-review ranking process, acceptances to be sent out by September 20, 2026.
- Authors must use the 2026 CAJC template to submit abstracts and papers. These templates are available in our online submission system (see below).
- **All submissions are now due August 24, 2026.**

Outstanding Research Competition

A short list of outstanding candidates will be selected by the Academic Committee upon submission. Papers and presentations of the candidates on the short list will be judged at the conference by the Competition Review Committee. Only full papers by CMBES or APIBQ members are eligible for this competition. **The winner receives \$2000.**

Student Paper Competition

Undergraduate and Graduate Students are invited to submit abstracts or papers. Only students who are members of CMBES or APIBQ will be eligible. **The top three student presentations will win a cash prize (\$500, \$300, \$200).**
